#### **Re-Certification Guidelines**

## Retaining Your ICN Pro Status

Annual Re-certification is required to keep your ICN Pro designation active.

### Annual Re-certification

Annual Re-certification of your designation is granted based upon the accumulation of continuing education points and remittance of a required fee. It entails filling out an Annual Re-certification Update Form to keep your mailing information to date. uр this Continuing completing Education Points Form, and returning both forms and a **\$30 fee** to the IGIA office. A letter reminding you that your Re-certification Annual approaching will be sent along with the proper forms, prior to December 31<sup>st</sup> Rethe certification date.

# **Continuing Education Points**

Continuing Education Points can be obtained in a variety of ways. Four (4) Continuing Education Points are required for Recertification every year. At least two (2) of your Continuing Education Points need to be obtained through educational horticulture-related programs. Should you decide not to seek continuing education points, you may obtain Re-certification by retaking and passing the ICN Protest.

### Continuing Education Point Schedule

Point(s) are received for participation in the following:

- Industry Educational Program:
  - 1/2 point per 1/2 day session (any professional horticulture-related program)
- College Classes:
   1 point per semester hour (must be in horticulture field)
- IGIA-sponsored, hosted or coordinated Education Event or Trade Show:
   1 point per day (i.e. InVigorateU, Growers Tour, Retail Tour, Design Seminar, etc.)

- Non-IGIA Trade Show/ Field Day, etc.:
   ½ point per day (1 point maximum per event)
- Staffing of IGIA booth or other industry-related booth for the IGIA:
   1 point per ½ day shift (i.e. State Fair, InVigorateU, etc.)
- Articles published in Trending Green or other media publications:
   1 point per article (300 words)
- Speaking Engagements:
   1 point (may include in-store seminars, radio/TV programs, etc.)
- Mentoring Program:
  2 points
  (tutor employee or
  colleague as they prepare
  to take ICN exam, ICN will
  receive points upon
  individual successfully
  passing exam)
- Assisting IGIA staff at ICN Pro exam:
   1 point
- IGIA Committee Work:
   1 point (1 point per year maximum per committee)
- REFERRAL: refer an exam candidate to program
   1 point
- <u>REQUIRED</u>...Attendance at an official IGIA function or event
   1 point (\*\*\*This point is mandatory!\*\*\*)

#### Record Keeping:

You are responsible for keeping track of your own Continuing Education Points. Suitable documentation must be submitted along with this continuing education point form (i.e. name badge from class or seminar, registration form from event, program booklet, etc.). It is suggested you keep a file for these documents so they can be easily gathered at the time of Recertification. Do not send materials prior to annual Recertification.
